Goal#3 Learn to Believe in the Future

- You will learn about the different educational alternatives and different professions or jobs
- You will learn about community resources to achieve our goals.
- You will learn a variety of ways with which you can positively contribute to your communities
- We will develop a Personal Leadership Plan that will helpyou achieve our goals and which we will use when we return to our homes and communities

You will visit the Capitol, La Fortaleza, and you will meet the sponsors of this activity during a very special luncheon. You will enjoy activities in which you will be able to show your talent for music, dancing, poetry... You will be able to show your physical abilities in challenging games and make new friends by sharing with other delegates from around the Island. You will learn about the different university programs available for you and the technology that can help you reach your goals.

Young people with disabilities that are in their second or third year of high school, and that are residents in Puerto Rico.
