Mental retardation

• There are four (4) types of mental retardation. These are: mild mental retardation, moderate mental retardation, severe mental retardation and profound mental retardation. Mental retardation implies an intellectual significantly low functioning (IQ 70 or less) of the brain that occurs jointly with a deficit in adapted behavior in at least 2 of the following areas of adapted conduct: communication, domestic life, interpersonal social abilities, use of community resources, self-control, work/leisure, health, security, and functional academic abilities. Mental Retardation manifests itself during developmental years and affects the school performance of the child.

Autism

Autism is a syndrome characterized by a psychological withdraw from reality, inappropriate
social relations, relations with things that are in the environment. It affects the use of language,
it produces motor movements that are repetitive, and also abnormal responses to sensations.
 Some of these children also have a deterioration in their intellectual functions. Autism occurs in
the early stages of development, and even though the cause is unknown, it is attributed to a
neurological disorder.

Muscular Dystrophy

• Muscular Dystrophy is an illness characterized by a deterioration of some muscles. The illness progresses slowly and usually occurs only on the skeletal muscles.
